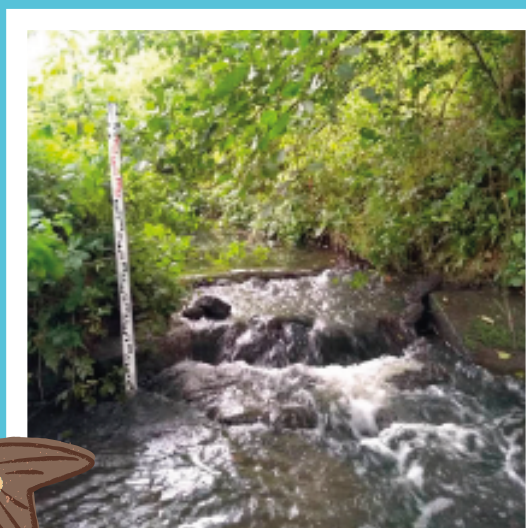


Celebrating **World Fish Migration Day** with our fish friends Brooke the Bullhead and Tommy the Trout in their Oakerthorpe Brook home

Before our recent project, the brook had several big weirs preventing fish and other wildlife from moving upstream. With help from our generous funders, we have removed 5 weirs and 35m of concrete bank, creating habitat features in the hope of welcoming back Brooke, Tom and all their other fish friends.



Breaking up the concrete has created new habitat and helps fish like Brooke and Tom by making it easier to swim upstream. We have also created an earth pile (with some of the removed concrete, wood and earth!) called a hibernaculum for newts, frogs and small snakes to hibernate for the winter.
